

Vision

Introduction

The celebrity on whom this souvenir has been brought forth is the Grama Seva Sangam (GSS), functioning at Kilikkudi Kudumiyanmalai in Pudukkottai District. It is situated towards the western Direction at a distance of 30 kilometers from the village, District Head Quarters. It must be proudly recorded on this memorable occasion that

this organization has won many laurels from all sources ever since its inception for its vital role of molding the society. The golden rule of the Sangam is 'Service Rendered to People is Service Rendered to the God'.

The Origin

It should be stated here that there is an underlying truth behind the origin of this organization. It was started in the year 1988 at first by Mr. Palanichamy, M.R. an ordinary person in the rural area. As a young boy hailing from a poor family in that small village Kilikkudi, he was deprived of his basic education due to his family circumstances. This was an unfortunate disappointment to him in his early life. This misfortune kindled his enthusiasm and inspiration which lead him to do something good for the rural poor and the backward mass. Later on, it became his unquenchable thirst that the depravity occurred to him in those days should not be the fate of other poor children too in that area. He had given a concrete shape to his thought at first in the year 1980 with the support of some like minded friends and oneness in spirit. Some how, they thought that illiteracy was the root cause for all human sufferings. Their well-meant effort helped many poor children to have an access to their basic education.

Later, in the year 1988 there originated a legally registered society in the name of Grama Seva Sangam with 11 members hailing from the same rural background. Their ultimate aim was to promote the conditions of the socio-economic educational community and its opportunities.

Initiative Programme

As the next step, a school was started in the year 1991 in Karambakkudi village in Pudukkottai district to cater to the educational needs of the local children in and around the village. 50 children were educated in the school. In the same village Sacred Grove development project was implemented by GSS through the support of Ministry of Environment in the early 1990s. It was the first notable rural service programme of the GSS which rendered its maximum service. But the Sangam was badly in need of financial support at that time.

Right Sharing of World Resources (RSWR)

The RSWR, Indiana, USA had kindly come forward to extend a small financial grant to GSS in the year 2000. Thus the RSWR rightfully empowered the poor women to make their own decisions to improve their own lives and the well being of their families and their communities.

We are highly dutiful to register here our gratitude to Mr. Kannan, the Indian Representative of RSWR who witnessed our works and created link for this funder to receive the grant without which we would have been in great trouble to carry out the programme successfully. The special efforts of Mr. G.V. Gopinath and V. Ramani, Project Consultants of GSS for the proper and successful implementation of the initiative programmes should always be remembered by us. It should be noted here that their valuable suggestions and efforts had helped us in a great deal for whom we are always grateful in this regard.



Further, some environmental related activities were implemented with the support of CPR Foundation in the year 1995, in order to create awareness among the agrarian community in and around Karambakkudi. Following this, three awareness and educational grammes were conducted so as to benefit the backward community involved in which agricultural works. Those programmes had undoubtedly increased their productivity in agriculture which was the main source of income to them. While things were proceeding in this way,

Nehru Yuva Kendra, Pudukkottai

NYK, Pudukkottai had kindly and timely extended an invitation to GSS to start an Adult Education Centre at Kilikkudi. As per this project, an Adult Education School was started in Kilikkudi village in the year 1995. During the following years, GSS had strengthened itself in its infrastructural capacities which attracted the Government Departments and other Donors in Abroad to create partnership with

GSS.

Child Labour Schools










As a next venture, the Child Labour Project Society, Pudukkottai, came forward to extend its support to GSS to run two special schools for Child Labourers in Kulathur Taluk in the year 1996. The Kinder Missions Werk, Germany had granted some worth mentioning funds to GSS on this occasion to support some components of the projects. This fund was properly utilized to distribute school uniform dresses to the children. Based on the better performances and achievements of GSS carried out so far in this way, the aforesaid society had allocated another three special

schools in favour of GSS. That programme covered 200 poor working children who were deprived of school education and rescued by us. The programme was successfully implemented for three years up to 1999. The dedication and commitment of GSS achieved cent percent child labour 0





eradication in its working areas and won a number of merit certificates and 'Best NGO Award in the District' among the 18 competitors and other NGOs. One of the worth mentioning award was the Best NGO Award presented by the then Hon'ble Minister of

Labour, Mr. Rehman Khan, Govt. of Tamil Nadu in the presence of the Pudukkottai District Collector on the occasion of a special function organized by the District Administration in the year 1999. Here it is the duty of our GSS to thankfully remember the dedicated services and supports of Mr. Joseph Ananda Raj, Project Director, Mr. Gopinath, Project Coordinator and Mr. Anbalagan and Mr. Marimuthu, Field Officers, District Child Labour Project Society.

SKIP-Switzerland

While all the programmes of GSS were going on beneficially to the rural community in a smooth way, a Child Labour Eradication Proposal submitted by us to a foreign agency and this proposal had been duly accepted and readily approved by the Foreign Donor SKIP-Switzerland considering the valuable credits earned by our organization in the previous years. This financial assistance was allocated to implement the "Education entitled and project Rehabilitation of Working Children in the Interior Villages of Annavasal Viralimalai Blocks of Pudukkottai District, Tamil Nadu", during the years from 2001 to 2004. This project was drafted properly by our project expert Mr. Gopinath, who rendered an yeomen service for the growth and development of our GSS. After studying this valuable project proposal in a deep way, our Country Representative for the SKIP, Mrs. Sherly Mathew and the Project Director of SKIP for India programmes, Mrs. Francoise Genode, Switzerland had given their valuable guidance and technical support to GSS for the effective and efficient implementation of the project. The total project period was 4 years. As our GSS wished to make use of this golden opportunity in a proper way, it decided to run 15 Child Labour Schools and 15 Supplementary Education Centres in selected 15 villages of Viralimalai and Annavasal Blocks in Pudukkottai District so that the educational needs of the area might be considerably fulfilled.





With a careful planning and sincere implementation of this project, various vocational skill training programmes such as Jute Bag making, Cloth Bags Manufacturing, Motor-Rewinding, Two-Wheeler Mechanism, Lab Technician, Book Binding, Light Motor Vehicle Driving, Computer DTP-Training programmes, Coir-Making, Pickle Preparing and Domestic Electronics, Off-set Printing etc., were conducted to create an employment access to the rural community. Moreover, our GSS donated School Bags, Text Books and remitted School Fees to the children of Non-Formal Education and Supplementary Education Centres in order to encourage children to go to schools regularly without any hindrance.



Other Programmes Supported by the SKIP:

1. A Model Self-Enterprise-Coir production Unit was started at Kallukkattupatti village in Rajalipatti Panchayat in order to create an access to a regular income for the people concerned.





- 2. Eye Camps and General Health Camps were jointly organized with the support of the Aravind Eye Hospital, Madurai and Siddha Health Camps were conducted and the camps distributed free medicines to the local villagers.
- 3. Leadership and Personality Development Training programmes for the rural Youth Groups and Women Self-Help Groups were conducted.



4. Training programmes on Record Maintenance and Induction Training programmes for the NFE* and SEC** Animators were also conducted.

- 5. Curriculum Development and Course Design for Non-Formal Education were prepared and valuable source books were also published.

They helped us to bring out various subject materials and Resource Books with their hard and continued efforts and services. Our organization was highly fortunate enough to utilize the long services of these potential people in the Education Department.

The SKIP Programmes were successfully implemented through the support of more than 50 staff in the field. They were a Project Coordinator, an Asst. Coordinator, an Accountant, and a Computer Operator and 4 Cluster Coordinators. We are grateful to the Chief Educational Officer, Pudukkottai, Asst. Educational Officers of Annavasal and Viralimalai Blocks and the local people,

farmers, women and youths of the project areas for their valuable support and guidance.

It might be a great default on the part of our GSS if we neglect a worth mentioning fact here. All the children enrolled under this NFE scheme in this area and the students enrolled under the Supplementary Education programmes were not given even a single chance to visit the neighboring places in and around this centre in their early life. But programme offered many golden opportunities to these unfortunate children to visit

so many worthy places and tourism centres. With the support of the SKIP programme, these children were brought to various notable places such as Kotralam, Thiruchendur, Kanyakumari, Thekkadi, Rameswaram, Ottapidaram, Madurai, Vaigai Dam in Tamil Nadu and Thirupathi in Andra Pradesh every year. These children were highly benefited by these Exposure visit programmes. They could earn very good educational and social awareness through these exposure visits.

Actually the SKIP Project was planned for 9 years. The project was implemented by our GSS with a grand success continuously. Various meritorious programmes were implemented year by year for four years until 2004. But due to their administrative reasons they had to left India half way. Seeing our successful implementation of the project, SKIP authorities recommended us to the Huarralde Foundation, Spain, an another notable Foreign Funding Agency to extend their funding assistance in favour of our continuous services.

Haurralde Foundation-Spain

Thus the fortune smiled on us again in our path. The Spanish Organisation namely, Haurralde Foundation rose to the occasion and they came forward to support us in the year 2006. They supported 13 Child Labour Schools to run again and thus those schools worked in order to reduce the number of school drop outs in the area. They funded for the following programmes in the subsequent years:

- Programme of distributing School Bags, Note Books and Stationeries to the children.
- 2. Programme of distributing school uniforms
- 3. Programme of Sponsorship to the regular school children hailing from Poor families
- 4. Income generating programmes

In addition to these programmes, 12 rural deserving girls were identified from the villages to be trained and serve as nurses with thus sufficient qualifications. Most of the girls were employed in government and they are also taking care of the medical needs of their respective villages.









GSS in Gujarat



Our GSS was given a rare opportunity to prolong its meritorious service in another state also. When this programme was going on successfully in Tamil Nadu, the Haurralde Foundation came forward to support us to implement their project in Gujarat which was not able to be implemented by thier partner in Gujarat. There they funded to GSS for the child sponsorship programme and educational profor mentally gramme challenged children for two years. We implemented these programmes successfully and it was one more feather on our cap. We should thankfully remember the support of Ms. Patricia. Director of Haurralde foundation and the volunteers from Spain, who visited our Service Centre in Gujarat in order to guide and evaluate our project implementation. Another notable person who helped and supported for the grand success of this project was Mr. P. Karunakaran. His selfless services and sincere efforts which moulded us should be recorded honestly and promptly. So, it is our gain that we extended our successful horizon towards the regions of other state also.





ACT India Network









In the way back of 2008, GSS evolved a state level network of NGOs who were addressing Global warming. More than 30 NGOs

joined in the Network. In the respective districts programmes relating to Global warming were implemented. The main focus of the Network was to sensitise the people about Global warming and educating about how to reduce carbon. The FEE forest Fund Organisation, Denmark, supported our network members to implement programmes in their respective regions. In collaboration with the National Social Service units in schools in Tamilnadu and Tamilnadu pollution cotrol board, we conducted various educational and awareness creation programmes. For three years the Network functioned in a strong and speedy manner and latter, it was resolved to dissolve the network so that each NGO might work in their respective region independently.



Watershed Programme

t is our great misfortune nowadays that we are getting only less rainfall every year. Due to this natural failure of monsoon, the productivity is also getting reduced substantially. So, it becomes our first and foremost necessity to impart technical expertise to the agrarian community in this regard so that they could adopt various methods in agricultural works according to the changing monsoons.

Our GSS had readily entered this field too and we appealed to the NABARD and the Government of Tamil Nadu to initiate

Watershed Development Project in its region. The proposal was approved and had been thus we implementing Watershed Project from 2004 onwards covering 16,304.84 hectares of land with the financial assistance of Rs. 38,429,486 and this project included the land area of the agro-horticulture. We distributed 16,126 seedlings plantation under this project. Following this, we distributed 14,148 seedlings Dry Land-Horticulture Agro-Forestry Schemes. Then 40,348 seedlings also were distributed by us which benefited 360,004 farmers in our region. After a long 10 years of the successful implementation of the project, the ground water level was f

> found to be increased substantially and the area of cultivation of crops was also increased. Thus it was found that productivity was also enhanced.

Mrs. Murugayi-with her Coir-Making Unit in-2002

She is in her Expanded Unit in -2014

I am Murgayi, from kallukattupatti village in Rajalipatti Panchayat. I belong to scheduled caste from very poor family background. We had no access to income as agriculture was not having much prospects due to monsoon failure. During such time in the year 2001, GSS started one Coir making unit to create income avenue

to the village people. I took up coir making training for three months. After training I started unit with three manual coir making machines under the support of GSS. After 12 years of my effort and encouragement and support of GSS funded by SKIP, Switzerland, I have enlarged the unit with 4 automatic coir spinning machines and one coir pith cleaning machine. At present, 7 women are working in this unit. My monthly income is now Rs.25,000 to Rs. 35,000. I am also planning to start one coir-mates making unit in future. I am happy now. I have respect in the society. Thanks a lot to GSS

I am K.Arul Jothi, of Theravur village of Pudukkottai District. After completion of my 12th standard in the school, I could not continue my further study. My future was bleak. As I don't have any skill, I could not find any job. At that time, to my rescue, GSS started one livelihood and skill training programme under the support of SKIP, Switzerland. I took up Training on two wheeler mechanism for 6 months with stipend from GSS. After taking up training, I got job in Saradha Motors as a store manager and earning Rs. 10,000 per month. Unless GSS had not helped me, my life would have been different, but now I am happy and I am always grateful to GSS and never forget their support





I am Ms. A. Sumathi (20) D/o Annamalai from the village, Malaikudipatti. I am the 3rd girl child out of total 6 girl children in my family. My father is a agricultural cooli and my mother Mrs. Rajeswari is a masonry assistant, who made a painstaking travelling every day to Trichy town from Malaikudipatti to find a labour work. Amid such family condition, Ms. Sumathi completed my Higher secondary study and unable to continue my further study due to severe financial crunch of my family and I joined as an assisstant in a Private Hospital at Trichy for more than 3 years with a salary of Rs. 6,000/- month. One day Ioccasionally met the project coordinator of GSS and known about the GSS sponsored free Nursing and Midwifery Assistant Training programme under the Haurralde Foundation's sponsorship programme. For my interest, I have been selected and undergone the aforesaid training programme from Holy Family Training Institute, Fathima Nagar,

Trichy. GSS paid all the fees for the training. After the successful completion of the training course, I got a job as Nursing Assistant in the Government Primary Health Centre at Bodi Mettu village in Theni District. Now, I am earning Rs. 12,000/month. I am glad too, because I am self supporting and self-reliant, reduce the pathetic condition of my family and support to my parents". As and when I come to my village I take care the medical needs of our village for free of cost. I am bound to thank GSS and Haurralde foundation, spain for their support.







"My name is Sethuraman S/o Aran. I am a poor farmer and I belong to scheduled caste. I have an area of nearly 2 Acre rain fed area and look after my paddy field. I am leading my help only with the help of the income obtained from the harvested paddy in this only field. I am totally dependent of this field

in this only field. I am totally dependent of this field only and have no other source income. The NGO, GSS, Kilikkudi approached me and told about the uses of Farm pond which harvest the rainwater in rainy season and helps to irrigate my paddy crop when irregular rainy periods. I trusted their words and they excavated a Farm pond in my field. In my earlier cultivation, I have suffered a lot of want of periodical watering for my cultivated fields. There would be no sufficient water for my crops from second and third watering. During this rainy season, the farm pond was filled and the stored water was very useful in second and third watering for my crops. If there was no water all my paddy would have been turned in to straw. I am very grateful to the people who have brought this Farm pond scheme and implemented in my field under watershed project through the support of NABARD Bank and TAWDEVA and made me live happily than ever".
